NISEI SOLDIER EXPERIENCE TRAVELING EXHIBIT



The National Museum of the United States Army shares their latest collaboration effort with the National Veterans Network (NVN) and The Army Historical Foundation in support of a Nisei Soldier traveling exhibition scheduled to begin in 2026.

This new traveling exhibit will embark on a five-year journey to 11 cities across the United States starting in 2026. The traveling exhibit is scheduled to be hosted in the following states: San Francisco CA, Honolulu HI, Portland OR, Los Angeles CA, Utah, Colorado, Minnesota, Texas, Georgia, Illinois and New York.



The Nisei Soldier Traveling Exhibit will feature the history of the U.S. Army's 100th Infantry Battalion, 442nd RCT and Military Intelligence Service who served in segregated units in World War II.
